

## **MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL**

Held on Monday, October 31, 2011

6:30 PM

### **CALL TO ORDER**

The special meeting of Sidney City Council was called to order at 6:30 PM, Monday, October 31, 2011, with Mayor Mike Barhorst presiding.

### **ROLL CALL**

The following Council members were present and answered roll call: Mike Barhorst, Frank Mariano, Katie McMillan, Tom Miller, Mardie Milligan, and Steve Wagner.

Also attending was: Interim City Manager Tom Judy and HR Manager Vickie Allen. Consultant Matt Kridler was in attendance.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION** – Purpose of considering the resumes and applications for the appointment of a City Manager.

At 6:33 p.m. Councilman Miller moved to go into executive session for the above stated purposes. Council member McMillan seconded the motion; motion passed by roll call.

At 7:12 p.m. Councilman Mariano moved to come out of executive session. Motion was seconded by Councilman Wagner. Upon roll call, motion passed unanimously.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

Councilman Miller moved, and Councilman Wagner seconded, to excuse Councilman Pellman from the meeting. Motion passed unanimously by roll call.

Mayor Barhorst reminded Council of the first round of interviews for the new City Manager, scheduled for Saturday, November 19, 2011. Special meeting will begin at 8:45 a.m.; lunch will be provided. Newly elected Council members will be invited to join the current Council for these interviews.

### **COUNCIL COMMENTS/INTERIM CITY MANAGER REPORT**

ICM Judy led a discussion regarding the annual employee holiday luncheon. Several options were proposed for City Council to consider for the 2011 event. Council directed staff to survey the employees on the appropriateness of the event and/or other options to show appreciation to

the employees for their hard efforts during the past year. This item will be addressed at the November 7, 2011 Workshop meeting.

Council member Milligan reported on a conversation with Scott Dorsey regarding ROW issues on Linden Avenue. She explained to Mr. Dorsey that the City could not make an exception to the Ordinances for one property owner.

Councilman Miller received a complaint from an Armstrong Drive resident regarding leaf pick up and the location for the leaves between the sidewalk and the curb. Educating the residents is important for this service.

At 7:40 p.m. Councilman Wagner moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Council member Milligan. Motion passed by unanimous roll call and the meeting was adjourned.
