

TRAFFIC/CRIMINAL PAYMENT PLAN

In most cases, you will be permitted to make monthly payments on costs and fines owed to this Court. In order to be placed on the payment plan, you must appear in Court, be ordered to pay fines and costs, and request that the Judge allow a payment plan. If you are convicted of an offense higher than a minor misdemeanor, you will also be placed on probation until all obligations to this Court are fulfilled. This includes payment of all costs and fines owing. Please see the "PROBATION" tab for further information on the rules and regulations for probation. If you are convicted of a minor misdemeanor and are placed on a payment plan, you will still be required to show a probation officer documentation of your payments and/or report in to the probation officer assigned to your payment plan. You will be required to sign paperwork attesting to your agreement to make regular monthly payments toward any fines, costs and/or restitution.
