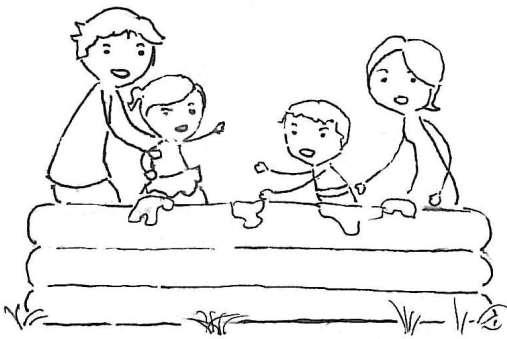


Regulations for Seasonal Swimming Pools



Do you have, or plan to set up:

- A pool that is capable of having a water depth of less than 24 inches?
- A pool that has a surface area of less than 150 square feet (less than 14 feet across for a circular pool)?
- Will you be using an electric motor for the pool?

If you answered "Yes" to the above questions, you may need a Temporary Pool Permit.

Permits Requirements

Seasonal or temporary pools **MAY** require a **Temporary Pool Permit** if an electric pump is used.

Recirculation and/or filtering pumps are often required or encouraged, especially for larger seasonal pools.

If you have a seasonal pool and you use an electric pump, even if you have had one in past years, you will need to have a permit and inspection completed by the City of Sidney Building Inspector.

***NOTE:** If your pool is capable of a water depth of 24 inches or more and a surface area of 150 square feet or more (14 foot or more diameter for a circular pool), then an Above Ground Swimming Pool Permit is required, even if you intend to remove and store the pool over winter.*
