Bids will be received by the City of Sidney electronically through Bid Express until **10:30 a.m. (EST) on Thursday, February 26, 2026**, at which time they will be electronically opened and reviewed.

Plans, Specifications, and bid forms will be available through the Bid Express website at www.bidexpress.com. All electronic bidders must register with Bid Express in order to submit a bid (please allow time for processing). Registration with Bid Express is free. Contractors and/or Subcontractors can view and download information free of charge. In order to submit an electronic bid, the bidder will need to pay a per bid fee or a monthly subscription fee for unlimited bids. We encourage bidders to familiarize themselves with the Bid Express service in advance.

If the bidder experiences difficulties with the electronic bidding service, please contact the Bid Express support team (1-888-352-2439, M-F 7 am – 8 pm EST or support@bidexpress.com) at least 72 hours prior to the bid opening.

The project will include removal and disposal of lime softened sludge from the Water Treatment Plant storage lagoon to an approved agricultural site for land application. The estimated dry ton amounts will be based on the City's yearly budgeted amount.


